The philosophical questions and issues explored by the medieval masters continued to play a role in the thought of the Renaissance and Early Modern periods. The essays collected in this volume, divided into three parts - Knowledge, Contemplation, and Lullism - study this influence through the lens of Ramon Llull s Art. They represent the contributions made by scholars of Llull to the 2012 Congress of the Societe Internationale pour l Etude de la Philosophie Medievale (SIEPM) held in Freising, Germany. The contributions focus on the philosophical implications of Llull s thought in areas such as geometry, logic, methodology, and Early Modern law. The SIEPM Congresses in Palermo, 2007, and Freising, 2012, both held meetings devoted to Llull s thought. This continued interest in Llull reinforced the constitution of a Lullian Section supported by the SIEPM Bureau (Commission of Latin Philosophy). Since its foundation, this research network has promoted academic research leading to new insights into Llull s work as a vehicle for medieval philosophical concerns and into the history of its reception.
